Accessible Voting Device

The accessibility devices of the electoral system “**vo.ar**” have been developed in cooperation with the Argentine Federation of Institutions of Blind and Amblyopes (FAICA for its name in spanish).

The innovations achieved, are not only reflected in the solutions for voting machines but also in the creation of devices that have been used in Argentina's national elections, to ensure that citizens with visual impairment can vote with complete autonomy, respecting their right to maintain the secrecy of their vote.

ACRYLIC

The Vo.Ar machine has an acrylic keyboard that rests on the screen and allows the visually impaired persons to vote. In this case, the system is executed in an audible and private way, with the use of
